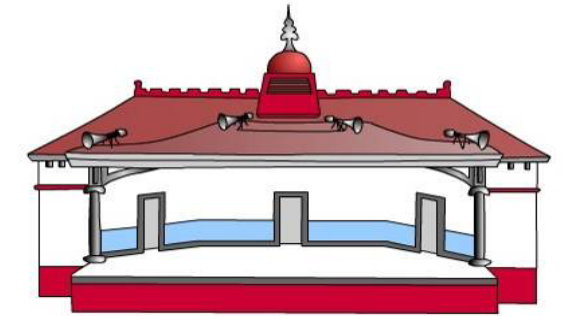

Strategic Brief – Key Aims

- To preserve the fabric of this unique building for the enjoyment of future generations.
- To create an open air performance space, fully equipped with modern facilities and improved infrastructure to facilitate the hosting of a variety of events, both in terms of scale and technical requirements.
- To improve the appearance of the park area and make it more welcoming and accessible for the general public, local residents and visitors to Glasgow.

Roles

- Glasgow City Council:**
Owners of the bandstand & amphitheatre. Will lease to GBPT during the capital works and assign to Glasgow Life on completion of the works
- Glasgow Building Preservation Trust:**
Will make funding applications and deliver the building contract
- Glasgow Life:**
Will lease, manage and programme events after completion
